Information & Reports

1. The final concert of the season will be held Thursday night at the PAC featuring the HS Choirs.
2. The Rubber Duck Regatta netted nearly \$6000 for the Excellence in Education Fund. Proposals have been selected for funding and are ready to be implemented. Thanks to the three service clubs involved: Rotary, Lions, and Kiwanis.
3. The MS PTO purchased and on Wednesday installed a new electronic sign in front of the Middle School. Thanks for your support MS PTO.
4. Two Policy Monitoring Reports were presented and approved. The first dealt with financial planning (Policy 2201), the second was on staff compensation and benefits (Policy 2203).
