

**Board Briefs**  
**Wednesday, February 9, 2011**

Information and Reports

1. Students will present *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat* the weekend of Feb 17-19 at the PAC.
2. High School Senior Nick Koste has been named a National Merit Finalist.
3. The Wolverine Conference is continuing to plan for the 2011-12 school year as Gull Lake leaves the conference in all sports except football. Letters of interest are going out to regional schools to find out if they are interested in being considered for inclusion in the league.
4. District leadership will be reviewing Ad Regs relative to Graduation Requirements. With the expected inclusion of the World Language requirement and other possible changes our Ad Regs will need to be reviewed and revised.
5. Registration is now open for the Governor's Education Summit to be held on April 25<sup>th</sup>.
6. Principals were recognized by President, Karen Ayres, as part of Michigan Principals' Week...Feb 14-18.
7. The Monitoring Report for Policy 2600...District Emergencies was presented and approved.

Actions
